On 3 July 2019, EHRI organizes a major international conference that marks the conclusion of the second phase of the ongoing project. The conference is open to anyone who is interested in Holocaust Studies, its latest developments and impact on society.

The conference *Holocaust Studies and its Social Setting: Challenges and Trends* will focus on the importance of EHRI's human network and the public dimension of Holocaust Studies.
